## INSTALLING THE GAME

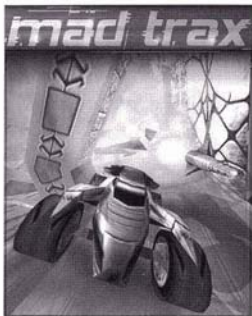
- Launch Windows 95.
- Place MAD-TRAX CD in your CD-ROM drive.
- The installation program should appear on the screen automatically. If this does not happen, double-click on the setup program on the CD-ROM.
- Click on **INSTALL** in the menu.
- Choose the right configuration for your system and click on **OK**. The higher the level of the installation you choose, the greater the amount of space the game will take up on your hard disk, but you will have faster access to the various menus.

When installation is complete, you may need to reboot the computer. Once you have done so, to launch MAD-TRAX simply select **Project Two / MAD-TRAX / Play MAD-TRAX** in the Windows task bar.

## IMPORTANT NOTE:

When you play you must first disable your screen-saver.

When playing the game you may need to calibrate your joystick under Windows.

## MENUS

### GENERAL USE

To Navigate into Menu Screen

Press **Left/Right** arrow keys.

To Enter a Menu,

Press **Enter** Key.

To Quit a Menu

Press **ESC** Key.

To Quit The Game

Press **ESC** Key from the **Main Menu** only.

## ONE PLAYER

### SIMPLE RACE



In this mode you can play any track but you will only be ranked in the **Best Laps Records**.



- Select a Track using **Left/Right** arrow keys.
- Press **Enter** when ready
- Start Racing!

### LEAGUE



In this mode the player must compete for a full season (20 races). The points acquired in **League Mode** are accumulated from one race to the next; the driver who has gathered most points over the 20 races becomes MAD-TRAX Champion.

Points are allocated for each position after a race as follows:

1st	15	points
2nd	11	points
3rd	8	points
4th	6	points
5th	3	points
6th	2	point
7th	1	point
8th	0	points!

(\*) If the player scores the maximum number of points in one season (being ranked first on each track), a last challenge might be available...!

## Continue League



- Select a **Track** using **Left/Right** arrow keys.
- Press **ENTER** when ready
- Continue racing in the current League!

## Select League



- Press **Up/Down** arrow keys to **Select a League** if any.
- Press **ENTER** once Selected.
- Press **ESC** to return to **League** Menu Screen.

## New League



- Enter the **Name** of the League you want to create.
- Press **ENTER** once Done.

## Delete League



- Press Up/Down arrow keys to Select a League if any.
- Press Enter to Delete the Selected League.
- Press ESC to return to League Menu Screen.

## Hall Of Fame

View Ranking Screen for the current League.  
Press ESC to return to League Menu Screen.

## TIME ATTACK



In this Mode you race against time.

- Select a Track using Left/Right arrow keys.
- Press Enter when ready!

## DUEL



In Duel Mode you can play in Two Players Split Screen Mode.

- 1 Select a Track using Left/Right arrow keys.
- 2 Press Enter when ready.
- 3 Start Racing!

## OPTIONS



## GAME OPTIONS

Use **Up/Down arrow keys** to navigate in this Menu.

### Difficulty Level

You can select to make the game easier or harder using **Left/Right arrow keys**.

EASY - MEDIUM - HARD

### Number Of Laps

Use **Left/Right arrow keys** to decrease/increase the number of Laps you want to race.

Pressing the **Shift Key** simultaneously will increase the number by 10 instead of 1.

### Weapons

Use **Left/Right arrow keys** to modify this option. When turned off, no weapons or any other on track options will be available. (ON/OFF)

### Number Of Competitors

Use **Left/Right arrow keys** to increase/decrease the number of competitors.

## PLAYER OPTIONS



### Select Player

Use **Left/Right arrow keys** to select your Player. (*Player1/Player2*)

### Player Name

- Enter your name
- Press **Enter** when ready

### Controls

Press **Enter** to modify the controls. This menu enables the player to select the keyboard and other game devices. The Keyboard and Joystick (default set-up)

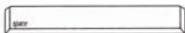

## Car Select



- Use **Left/Right** arrow keys to Select a car.
- Press **ENTER** to modify the parameters.

When modifying one of the following set-ups one or all of the other parameters will automatically be adjusted. Each time you increase/decrease one of the parameters of your car setting the others will automatically adjust themselves.

- Use **Left/Right** arrow keys to decrease/ increase each parameter.
- Use **Up/Down** arrow keys to go to the next parameter.

## Steering angle

The more steering angle, the steeper and faster your car turns.

## Speed

The higher the engine power, the higher the maximum speed.

## Acceleration

The faster the acceleration, the faster you reach the maximum speed.

## Track Tuning

Press **Enter** to enter **Track Selection Menu**.

- Select a Track using **Left/Right** arrow keys.
- Press **Enter** when ready
- Start Tuning your car on this track!

## SOUND OPTIONS



You can modify the **Sound Effects** and **Music Volume**.

Use **Left/Right** arrow keys to decrease / increase each parameter.

Use **Up/Down** arrow keys to go to the next parameter.

## GRAPHIC OPTIONS



Use **Left/Right arrow keys** to modify each parameter.  
Use **Up/Down arrow keys** to go to the next parameter.

## WEAPONS/BOOSTS

Weapons are displayed on the tracks and you must drive over to pick them up and be able to use them.

You can only use one of them at a time and only the last one you picked up is used.

### Missiles

Some are auto-guided while others fly straight ahead.

### Mines

Mines just blow up when you drive over them.

### Boosts

They increase your speed for a given time.

### Invulnerability

You cannot be shot while invulnerable.
