# ***INSTALLING THE GAME***

## **To install Need For Speed™ Underground 2:**


- 1.** Close all open programs and background tasks, including virus scanners (see *Performance Tips* on p. 10 for more info).
- 2.** Insert the *Need For Speed Underground 2* Disc 1 into your CD/DVD-ROM drive. The Autorun menu appears.

**NOTE:** If the Autorun menu does not automatically appear, left-click the  **Start** button from the Windows® Taskbar and select **Run...** Type **D:\autorun.exe** in the Run dialog box, then click OK [substitute the correct letter of your CD/DVD-ROM drive if other than 'D:'].

- 3.** Click the **INSTALL** button on the Autorun menu, then follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation.

## **To start Need For Speed Underground 2 (with disc already in drive):**

- 1.** Close all open programs and background tasks, including virus scanners (see *Performance Tips* on p. 10 for more info).
- 2.** Left-click the  **Start** button from the Windows Taskbar and select **All Programs** (or **Programs**) > **EA GAMES** > **Need for Speed Underground 2** > **Need for Speed Underground 2**.

Once your ride is up to speed, take it to the streets in one of the all-new racing modes like Street X and Downhill Drift. Think you've got what it takes to make it in the underground? Here's your chance to prove it.

# ***SETTING UP THE GAME***

Get into the underground.

## ***MAIN MENU***

- CAREER** Conquer Career mode and rule the underground (see p. 6).
- QUICK RACE** Jump right into a race (see p. 7).
- ONLINE** Race against friends online (see p. 7).
- LAN** Race others on a local area network (see p. 9).
- CUSTOMIZE** Outfit your ride from bumper to headlights (see p. 4).
- PROFILE MANAGER** Save or load your game (see p. 9).
- OPTIONS** Adjust audio, video, and gameplay options (see below).

## ***OPTIONS***

To access the Options menu from the Main menu, click OPTIONS.

To access the Options menu in-game, enter the Pause menu then select OPTIONS.

- AUDIO** Set in-game volume levels or select an audio mode.
- DISPLAY** Adjust video options.
- GAMEPLAY** Adjust the jump camera, rearview mirror, speedometer units, career difficulty level, and map modes, or toggle the autosave feature.
- PLAYER** Choose a transmission type, select stability control, change the default camera, or toggle heads-up display content ON/OFF.
- CONTROLS** Change the game controls.
- EA GAMES™ TRAX** Adjust Music Playback options.

## ***GAME SCREEN***



## ***CUSTOMIZE YOUR RIDE***

Competing in the underground requires an eye-catching combination of speed and beauty. Choose from hundreds of performance parts and visual customization modifications available in *Need For Speed Underground 2* to make your ride look good over and under the hood.

### ***SELECT A CAR***

Your ride makes or breaks your reputation in the underground. Looks are important, but no one pays attention to a car that's running dead last.

### ***MAKE AND MODEL***

Browse the available cars, but don't think of them as finished products. With a few wins under your belt you'll be customizing these basic vehicles into exquisite street machines that car dealers will barely recognize.

- When picking a car, check out the Acceleration, Top Speed, and Handling ratings at the bottom of the screen. Performance modifications can improve these characteristics later, but you'll need to win some races with your stock vehicle in order to fund any serious work under the hood.

### ***CUSTOMIZING***

New cars are nice in the showroom, but there's plenty of room for improvement once they hit the streets. Make your car your own through a thorough customization process. A vast array of modifications are available for your ride—if you've got the bank, that is.

- To begin customizing your vehicle, click CUSTOMIZE in the Main menu.
- To switch cars, click the arrows.
- To toggle between stock cars and the cars you own, click the arrows on the filter bar on the top right side of the screen.

## **VISUAL STAR RATING**

You can contribute to your visual star rating by making your car look smooth and upgrading your performance. As you modify your car, your star value increases. The star value contributes to your progression through the game by rewarding you with DVD covers and money.

→ The maximum number of stars you can earn is ten.

## **VISUAL MODS**

Style is in the details, so *Need for Speed Underground 2* leaves the details up to you. Choose from dozens of styles of hoods, rims, body kits, exhaust tips, spoilers, side mirrors, and more. Transform your car's surfaces with pearlescent, gloss, or metallic paint, vinyl graphics, positional decals, window tints, and neon. There's also a car specialty shop that allows you to install hydraulics, add some scissor doors or spinners, and put in some trunk audio.

## **VINYLS**

Vinyls are distinctive graphics that stick to your car's bodywork. They can be placed in up to four layers, allowing you to stack graphics for a collage effect. Each vinyl's color can also be customized, to further individualize your car's look.

→ To stack vinyls, place the first vinyl on the bottom layer and then select a different layer for the next vinyl. The new vinyl is placed on top while leaving the first one undisturbed. You also have the ability to reorder the layers to get the perfect look.

## **PERFORMANCE MODS**

Let's face it, the automotive engineers who designed these cars never thought they could go this fast. Today's tuner culture hungers for speed, so they've enhanced every aspect of automotive performance with hundreds of aftermarket parts. *Need for Speed Underground 2* offers hundreds of modifications, including weight reduction, nitrous oxide, suspension kits, ECUs, and advanced fuel systems. Add all of this available power to your car and just keeping it under control could be a challenge.

## **HYDRAULICS**

If you have hydraulics installed on your car they are automatically enabled. Once you exceed 30 mph they are automatically disabled.

- To pressurize, hold **[H]** and use the steering/throttle controls to indicate the section of the car that should use hydraulics.
- To bounce with level 3 hydraulics, hold **[J]** and use the steering/throttle controls to indicate the direction you wish to bounce.

# GAME MODES

Take on the underground in a variety of Quick Race mode races or Career mode.

## CAREER MODE

Rise to the top of the underground in Career mode.

→ To start a game in Career mode, click CAREER in the Main menu then either create a new profile or load an existing profile.

## EXPLORING

Want to make a name for yourself in the underground? You're going to have to find it first. In Career mode, the city is yours to discover. Explore it by driving around to get a feel for the lay of the land. As you cruise you'll encounter rival racers who you can challenge to an Outrun race. Keep your eyes and ears open for hints pointing you to the areas where you can find the hottest races or the coolest upgrades.

→ If you perform a cool move while you cruise, such as impressive slides, you earn points. These fill up your Race Breaker meter if you have nitrous installed. Do something uncool, like hit another driver, and points are deducted from your Race Breaker meter.

## SHOWCASE MODE

As you win races and upgrade your car, you will receive messages telling you to proceed to locations where a photographer is waiting to take a picture of your suped-up ride. To set up the best shot you can pop your hood, trunk, or doors to better show off the goods.

→ To open or close the doors, press **[←/→]** or **[A/D]**.

→ To open or close the hood, press **[↑]** or **[W]**.

→ To open or close the trunk, press **[↓]** or **[S]**.

→ To exit this mode, press **[ESC]** or click BACK.

## SMS

Messages from other SMS users offer you details on races, car shops, challengers, and opportunities.

→ When you see the SMS icon appear on-screen, press **[TAB]**. The game pauses and your messages appear.

→ To return to the game from the Inbox, press **[ESC]** or click BACK.

→ To return to the game from within a message, press **[ENTER]** or click CONTINUE.

## WORLD MAP

The world map offers a bird's-eye view of the entire city. Icons representing your car, opponents, and the locations of potential races and shops also appear here.

→ To access the world map, press **[M]**.

→ To activate the GPS, click on the shop or event on the map legend or directly on the map.

→ To hide/show shops or events on the map, click on them in the map legend.

→ To return to the game, press **[ESC]** or click BACK.



## **QUICK RACE MODE**

Jump into the driver's seat and let the race begin.

### **To start a quick race:**

1. Click QUICK RACE in the Main menu.
2. Choose between CIRCUIT, SPRINT, DRAG, DRIFT, STREET X, UNDERGROUND RACING LEAGUE, or FREE RUN modes.
3. Select a location for your race.
4. Adjust race options.
5. Select a vehicle.
6. Choose a MANUAL or AUTOMATIC transmission. The race begins.

<b>CIRCUIT</b>	A traditional lap-style course. Finish first and leave your competitors driving in circles.
<b>SPRINT</b>	Find out how fast you can get from point A to point B.
<b>DRAG</b>	A pedal-mashing, speed-shifting race to the finish line.
<b>DRIFT</b>	Break loose into a stylish drift and rack up the points.
<b>STREET X</b>	Lap-based racing on tight and technical closed circuits. Fight for first place whatever the cost.
<b>UNDERGROUND RACING LEAGUE</b>	Lap-based racing on dedicated racetracks.
<b>FREE RUN</b>	No competition. No time limit. No rules. The open road beckons.

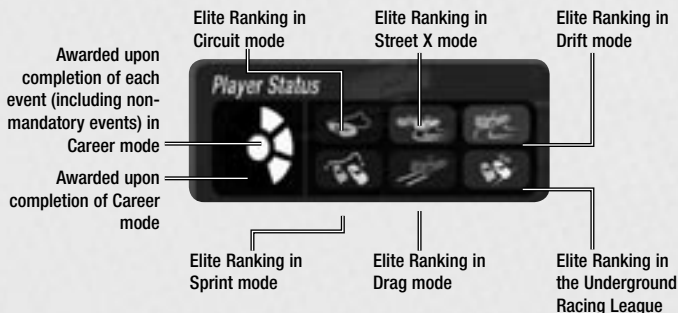

  - To filter the list of online games, click **FILTER**. You may filter by game mode, car performance, game type, race breaker, and collision detection.

### To create a new online game:

1. Select **LOBBY** in the Online menu.
2. Click **CREATE NEW GAME**.
3. Choose between a **CIRCUIT**, **SPRINT**, **DRAG**, **DRIFT**, **STREET X**, **UNDERGROUND RACING LEAGUE**, or **OUTRUN** race.
4. Select the location of the race.
5. Adjust race mode options and click **DONE** to advance to the game lobby.

# **PERFORMANCE TIPS**

## **SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS**

It is essential that your PC meets the Minimum Requirements as detailed on the game's packaging. If you are experiencing poor performance, check to make sure your system hardware supports the requirements.

## **BACKGROUND TASKS**

In some cases programs that are running on your system can monopolize resources that the game needs in order to install, load, and run properly. Not all of these programs are immediately visible. There are a number of programs, called "background tasks," that are always running on your system.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** While shutting down background tasks will optimize your system for running *Need For Speed Underground 2*, these background tasks' features will be unavailable once shut down. Be sure to re-enable background tasks after playing *Need For Speed Underground 2* by restarting your computer.

If your system is running anti-virus or crash guard programs you will need to close or disable them to run *Need For Speed Underground 2*. To do this, find the icon for the program on the Windows Taskbar and then right-click the icon and select "close," "disable," or the relevant option. Please note that these programs will be reactivated the next time you restart your computer.

Once anti-virus and crash guard programs have been disabled, you should end all unnecessary general background tasks.

### **To view and close background tasks (Windows XP):**

1. Hold down **CONTROL** and **ALT** and then tap **DELETE**. The Windows Task Manager appears.
2. Click the **Processes** tab. This tab displays a list of all background tasks running on your system.
3. Click the **User Name** column heading. This sorts all the processes together by user name.
4. Select an item with a user name, but DO NOT select one from the SYSTEM, LOCAL SERVICE, or NETWORK SERVICE groups. Also, DO NOT select the *explorer.exe* or *taskmgr.exe* items.
5. Click END PROCESS. You may receive a warning message, if so click YES. The selected item disappears from the list.
6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 until only *explorer.exe* and *taskmgr.exe* remain in the user name group.

### **To view and close background tasks (Windows Me or 98):**

1. Hold down **CONTROL** and **ALT** and then tap **DELETE**. The Close Program window appears. This window displays a list of all background tasks running on your system.
2. Select an item, but DO NOT select the *Explorer* or *Systray* items.
3. Click END TASK. The Close Program window closes and the task is ended.
4. Repeat steps 1 through 3 until only *Explorer* and *Systray* remain.

## **VIDEO AND SOUND DRIVERS**

An outdated video or sound driver can lead to slow and choppy gameplay, or in some cases can prevent the game from running at all. To ensure an enjoyable experience with *Need For Speed Underground 2*, be sure that you have the most recent video and sound drivers installed. These drivers are typically available for download from your system or hardware manufacturer's website. If you are not sure what type of video or sound card you have, or you don't know how to update the drivers on your system, please refer to the documentation that came with your system or peripheral.

# INTERNET PERFORMANCE ISSUES

To avoid poor performance during Internet play, be sure that you close any file sharing, streaming audio, or chat programs prior to entering gameplay. These applications can monopolize your connection's bandwidth, causing lag or other undesirable effects.






