- 1) Insert the CD-ROM.
- 2) When the splash screen appears, click on **Configure**. Refer to symptoms/solutions below for configuration options.
- 3) Once you have checked/un-checked the appropriate options, click on **OK** then click on **Play**.

SYMPTOM

The game plays, but sometimes crashes.

Un-check DirectSound.

If you have a 16-bit sound card,
check 16-bit sound.

If you have an 8-bit sound card,
check 8-bit sound.

The game starts, but then locks up.

Un-check DirectSound.

If you have a 16-bit sound
check 16-bit sound.

If you have an 8-bit sound car
check 8-bit sound.

Graphics appear to be shifted off-screen.

Un-check WinDirect, check DirectDraw

Graphics are discolored.

Un-check WinDirect, check DirectDraw

Get an MGL Fatal Graphics error when game is started.

Un-check WinDirect, check DirectDraw
