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Installation PC

Insert the CD into your CD Drive.

A window will appear asking if you would like to register for the Mindscape Club. (This registration enables you to receive promotional offers, updates and information on our products.)

Then the autorun window for *Thomas & Friends: Special Delivery* will appear.

Follow the instructions which appear on your screen.

If no autorun window appears, you can install the game manually:

- Click on **Start** followed by clicking **Run**.
- Type "D:\eautorun.exe" on the line entitled "Open:" (if the letter "D" does not correspond to your CD-ROM Drive, please replace it with the suitable letter).
- Click **OK**.

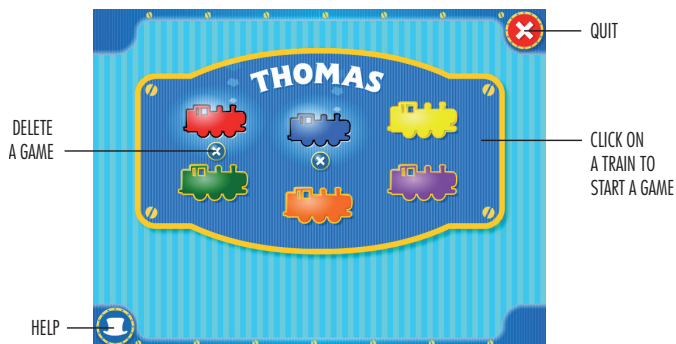
Your child will help Thomas, James and Harold to deliver the special cargo safe and sound at the zoo.

The session is saved: if you leave a game in the middle of playing, you can continue it later on.

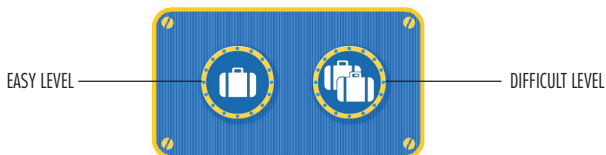
A cross placed under a train indicates that a game already exists. Just click on the train to continue the game, or click on the cross to delete it.

When creating a new game, you must select the difficulty level in which you wish to play the games. The level – easy or difficult – applies to the entire game and can no longer be changed during the game.

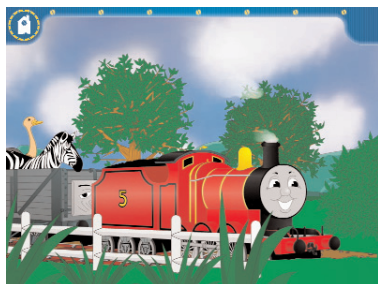
If you wish to change the difficulty level, you must create a new game, or play the games in Chapter mode.



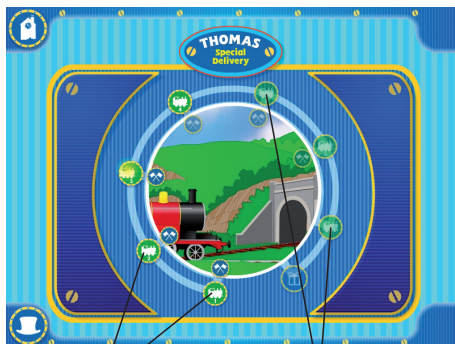


The main menu gives access to:
